**Distinguishing Between Roles/ Thespian Point Values**

## Major Role

One Act: 4
Full Length: 8
Description: A Major Role can be defined as the protagonist(s) and or antagonist(s) of the story. The Major Role is often the central focus of the plot. Major Roles can also include characters with their own subplots closely related to the protagonists' central plot. In a musical, a Major Role has one or more solos. In a play, a Major Role would be the person or people with the most amount of lines.

## Minor Role

One Act: 3
Full Length: 6
Description: A Minor Role is defined as a character who is not the central focus of the plot, but is still important. A Minor Role usually has a relation to the protagonist or antagonist such as: friend, sibling, parent, side-kick, co-worker, etc. Minor Roles are often "flat" and do not experience significant change throughout the story. In a musical,
a Minor Role may have a duet. In a play, a Minor Role has a few lines and appearances throughout the play.
