## Covid Company Contract

To produce the most professional rehearsal experience and show possible, Taft Theatre expects the following from each member of the cast/crew and so that we can adhere to all district and UIL safety guidelines:

- To be on time for each and every rehearsal, crew calls, or shows for which you are scheduled. Rehearsals will be Mondays - Thursdays starting Jan 4 from 5:00-7:00. All rehearsals will be in-person. Repeated tardiness may result in a lesser role or dismissal from the show. Do not leave before the director has dismissed you. Everyone is expected to continue rehearsal if we advance. All clinics, and all performances are MANDATORY.
- 2. The earliest possible notification is required if you must miss a scheduled call or rehearsal. Only a maximum total of two (2) excused absences will be allowed. Please note, for the three weeks prior to the show no rehearsals may be missed. Three (3) absences and you will be dismissed from the show.
- 3. Most costumes will be provided but cast members may be required to purchase some items, such as shoes, tights etc. Costumes will be treated respectfully, hung and placed in the designated area after each performance to be washed after every rehearsal. You will only touch and wear the clean costume assigned to you.
- 4. Do not alter your appearance or hair cut unless approved by the director. You were cast with a particular look in mind. Some actors may be asked to cut or dye their hair. Techs are required to wear all black during a performance.
- 5. You must wear a mask at all times, stay 6 feet or more apart, not touch each other or share props, and wash your hands regularly.
- 6. Appropriate behavior at all times. Most importantly to be quiet and considerate of those on stage while you are not. Failure to be respectful will lead to being asked to leave the rehearsal.
- 7. The learning of all lines, cue, prompts and music in a time frame determined by the Directors.
- 8. Care for all scripts. You are expected to have your script at every rehearsal. Scripts will NOT be replaced.
- 9. I must maintain a 70 average in all classes to remain eligible. *This closes on Dec. 19 and is based on your 2nd nine week grades, not the semester!*
- 10. You must agree to semi-quarantine for the safety of your fellow students. No social gatherings or hanging out with members outside of your household during the rehearsal process and show advancement. *In addition, you understand and agree to abide by and follow all NISD Covid Rehearsal/Performance protocols at all times.*
